Arapahoe CentrePoint Plaza opened for business in May, 2002 providing easy access to county services for residents living in Aurora and eastern Arapahoe County. The facility, located at 14980 East Alameda Drive, includes offices for Arapahoe/Douglas Works!, Assessor, County Commissioners, Human Services, and Information Services.

The 142,000 square foot facility is home to almost 400 employees. An estimated 1,000 visitors enter the building each day. It accommodates the distinct needs of foster parents coming and going with small children, families looking for financial help and job training, senior citizens applying for tax relief, and business people meeting with community leaders.



The large meeting room attached to a full kitchen is available to community groups and non-profit organizations. There is also a child care facility for parents doing business in the building.

The site was chosen in part because of its central location. It is easily accessible to highways I-25 and I-70 via I-225. Public transportation is readily available with no less than 15 bus stops within a half mile radius, including a major RTD hub at Aurora Mall.
