The Livonia Community Recreation Center has already made a mark on the community. Designed in a modernist style with contemporary materials and colors, the center is a reflection of the community's automobile heritage. This 130,000 s.f. center is one of the largest of its kind in the United States.

The center includes a leisure pool, lazy river, indoor water slide and separate 8-lane, 25-meter competitive lap pool, fitness area, climbing wall, a large 2-court gymnasium and an auxiliary (MAC) gym, walk/jog track, gymnastics room, aerobics room, classrooms, seniors lounge, and childcare area.
