## River Winds at West Deptford

The RiverWinds Community Center in West Deptford Township has transformed 1100 acres of Delaware River dredge spoils into a recreation-focused destination. The adverse geological and “brown field” environmental conditions required creative engineering and design solutions to accommodate development of this site in an area where open space is very scarce.

The 111,000 s.f. center is created of forms and materials that evoke memories of the riverfront architecture of past generations. The “Village” concept was designed by grouping multiple forms together into one building to reduce mass.

Leisure aquatics, two gyms, climbing wall, and weight training areas are joined with multipurpose banquet and meeting facilities.
